The MAG2 validation is just related to the 'No' on the QIA, not the MSF, therefore you need to select 'Disagree' on MAG2. The appraisal output summary form is yearly, not 5 yearly. Just to confirm MAG2 validation does also include Significant Events, Complaints and Compliments and Scope of Work if 'No' is selected.

The 'annual status' will therefore be red, however if you take a look at the revalidation summary it should become clearer when looking at the 'overall score' depending on how many appraisal output summaries have been completed.
